Special thanks to Tracey Telfer, the Cookery Tutor, Northtec and to Matua Wayne Albert for transporting our trades academy students this year.

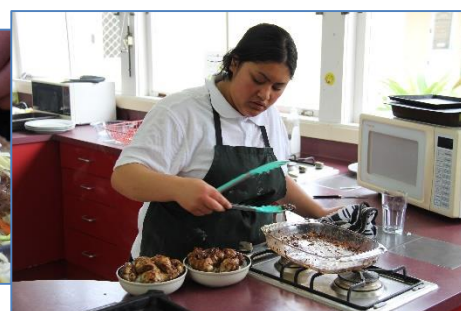


School Magazine
